Works to reinstate the bank and repair the fencing

Friday 6th February 2026


Dan Woollacott Fencing, on behalf of Devon County Council, will be carrying out works to reinstate the bank and repair the fencing on the Road from Ash Gate to Leeford Green between Monday 23rd – Friday 27th February 2026; our working hours will be between 09.00 – 17.00.

These works to repair the damaged bank on the road edge are necessary following a tree fall.

We will maintain access for residents and businesses but delays should be expected. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained. For safety reasons the road will be closed to all through traffic during our working hours.

Access queries should be directed to our Contractor or an operative on site who will be glad to assist.

Please see the road closure and works area highlighted in **red** on the map below, the signed diversion route is shown in **blue**. Drivers with local knowledge may use alternative routes but these will not be advertised for safety reasons.





Any changes to the start date or duration will be shown on advisory signs on site. We will do our best to complete the work quickly and minimise disruption. Your co-operation and understanding are greatly appreciated.
