## **Minutes of PC Meeting (26)**

**Held at the Brendon Village Hall on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020 at 7.30pm**

1. **Councillors Present:-** A Fletcher, S Adams, L Farthing, W Floyd. L Slade (RFO)

**Apologies:** G Woollacott, A Percival, P Young

2. **Declaration of interests:-** None

3. **Minutes:-** Of the last PC meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020 were agreed, proposed by W Floyd, seconded by S Adams . All Agreed.

4. **Matters Arising:-** None

5. Resolution to approve absence of Councillors at meetings (6month rule). Council gave due consideration to the absence of the following Councillors:- A Percival, P Young, G Woollacott and their reasons for non-attendance at meetings. It was resolved to approve their reasons. Proposed S Adams, seconded L Farthing. All agreed.

6. **Finance:-** The RFO requested authority to pay the following:- a) £54.00 to Vision ICT for (Assessibility Statement costs). Proposed A Fletcher, seconded W Floyd. All agreed.

b) £340.00 grass cutting fee (increased in line with RPI) . Proposed S Adams, seconded L Farthing.

Council's Bank Balance £ 4,807.00 after payment of the above.

7. **A.O.B.:-** Council heard that the restricted parking measures at the lane to Kitscombe was the result of the need to protect the S.S.S.I. status. Wooden posts have been erected to prevent vehicular incursions to the site. It is anticipated that normal access will be available shortly. In addition, the electricity generator at the Telecom Mast is a temporary measure whilst repairs are made to a failed underground cable.

The Clerk was instructed to report a pot hole in the road between Brendon Barton and Brendon Manor, and enquire regarding compulsory hedge cutting on Hall Lane.

It was agreed that Council would revert to bi-monthly meetings while current restriction apply.
