- 2. Declaration of Interests. None
- 3. Public participation. None
- **4. Approve minutes of last meeting.** Karen Wall proposed that the minutes of the last meeting be approved. This was seconded by Paul Grout and all agreed. Karen Wall signed the minutes for publication.
- **5. Matters arising.** Karen Wall informed the meeting that the new Village green sign for the Stahunters Inn had been returned to National Parks to have the distance amended.
- **6. Resilience Plan.** Paul Grout has agreed to be the lead in creating and distributing the Resilience Plan.

He will be arranging a meeting for the Parishioners, which will also have a member of the Environment Agency in attendance.

The Clerk will contact DALC to see if they can help.

The meeting agreed with this and potential costs will be brought to the next meeting for discussion.

8. Finance. The RFO asked for approval to pay ENP for the signs (after they have rectified the error in item 5) and the Village hall for rent (Jan - Jun). Karen Wall proposed that they be paid. John Atherton seconded and all agreed.

- 10. District Councillor's report. John Patrinos had previously sent in his monthly report which is available on the parish website.
- 11. AOB. John Atherton said that he was disappointed that the Village hall committee had decided not to install a broadband connection in the Village hall.

Annie Webber, who is a member of the Village hall committee, informed the Council that it was not financially viable. The cost of installation, line rental and the already high cost of electric heating would be more than the rent paid for meetings.

Nigel Webber asked about the missing sign post at Cross Lane. Andrea Davis said she would investigate.
